At 9:00 AM, on Tuesday, August 26, 2025, the Brown County Board of Commissioners met in Room #204 of the Brown County Courthouse located in New Ulm, Minnesota, 56073. Commissioners present were David Borchert, Anton Berg, Scott Windschitl, Brian Braun and Jeff Veerkamp, along with Lay Board Members DeeAnn Gieseke and Vicki Sieve, County Administrator Sam Hansen and Human Services Director Anne Broskoff.

Call to Order

1. Chairman Windschitl called to order the Regular Meeting at 9:00 AM. All present said the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. A motion was offered by Commissioner Braun, and was seconded by Commissioner Borchert, to accept the printed agenda. This motion duly carried.

7. Nathan Beran, IT Director, Anne Broskoff, Human Services Director, met with the County Board. A motion was offered by Commissioner Braun, and was seconded by Commissioner Borchert, to approve purchase of server software from CDW-G in the amount of \$35,706.13. An additional quote was received from SHI. This motion carried on a roll-call vote of 5-0.

8. Anne Broskoff, Human Services Director, Jesse Kral, Facilities Manager, met with the County Board. A motion was offered by Commissioner Berg, and was seconded by Commissioner Veerkamp, to approve planned expenditures for Human Services Lobby Remodel South Country Health Alliance grant funds in the amount of \$29,353.21, with direction to come back to the Board prior to installation for discussion on the audio portion of the quote. This motion carried on a roll-call vote of 5-0.

9. A motion was offered by Commissioner Veerkamp, and was seconded by Commissioner Windschitl, to accept and order file the Human Services Monthly Update Report Human Services Monthly Update. This motion duly carried.

10. Jaimee Brand, Public Health Director, met with the County Board. A motion was offered by Commissioner Braun, and was seconded by Commissioner Berg, to schedule a Public Hearing for 9:02am on September 23rd, 2025 for revisions to the Public Health Nuisance Ordinance. This motion duly carried.

11. Shawn Stoermann, Emergency Manager, Jeremy Reed, Chief Deputy, Andrew Lang, Engineer, met with the County Board. A motion was offered by Commissioner Veerkamp, and was seconded by Commissioner Borchert, to approve the purchase of 2 radar speed signs for Comfrey and Hanska. This motion duly carried.

12. Shawn Stoermann, Emergency Manager, Jeremy Reed, Chief Deputy, met with the County Board. A motion was offered by Commissioner Borchert, and was seconded by Commissioner Veerkamp, to approve purchase of an Autel Robotics EVO II 640T Drone bundle from Frontier Precision. Commissioner Braun reported on the Cottonwood 1W1P meeting, Wellness meeting, JD 5, and JD 36 meeting.

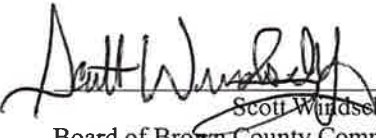
Commissioner Veerkamp reported on the JD 5 meeting, JD 36 meeting, AURI biodigester tour.
